New Track online group information sessions

These groups are for people who are looking for **new** employment or education opportunities.

We run these using Teams videocall software.

The online sessions are designed to share information and resources that you can use to explore options and supports to start your journey of finding a course or job. They are not peer support sessions.

You have the option of meeting with one of the team for a 15minute individual videocall or phone call.

This can help guide you as to which resources may best help you in your return to work or education journey.

- Work Preparation, Volunteering & 4Ps of symptom management.
- CV & Cover Letter Preparation
- Job Searching & Recruitment
